

 - If you are unsure of your precinct number or your voter ID number, both can be found on your voter registration card.
 You can also find your information at www.voteseminole.org/voters#findmyrecord
 - This form must be notarized. Do not sign this form unless you are present in front of a notary. There are notaries available at the membership meeting on the third Thursday of the month.

Onceyour application is complete, pleaseemail to Steve Collins, (precinct40@protonmail.me), SCRECSecretary&MembershipChair, who will processthe application. Completed applications must be received at least 10 days prior to next scheduled General Membership Meeting in order to be eligible for approval at that meeting.

Applications for membership are received and approved by the Executive Board. Candidate must be present at a General Membership Meeting, when a quorum is present, for the candidate's name to be on the ballot. Candidates are approved by the general membership. Once approved, you will be a full voting member at the next general meeting.
